





I actually bought this cd single after reading the great reviews the song recieved and I wasn't disappointed after hearing it. As usual Kristine W's vocals are excellent to say the least! There are some nice remixes on this cd maxi single starting with the "Peter Rauhofer Reconstruction Mix #" (10:05) with it's strong percussion, bassline, and synthesizers. This remix is my personal favorite. The "Gomi Big Mix" (8:08) has a retro disco feel which could have easily been sung by 70's artists The Emotions or First Choice. The "Murk Miami Mix" (8:21) has a deeper bassline, nice synthesizer stabs and interesting special effects. The "Southside Remix" (7:48) again has a deep bassline, lots of percussion and various synthesizers which complement Kristine's vocals. Last is the "Peter Rauhofer Radio Edit#" (3:35) which is a short version made for dance radio stations and the "Gomi Main radio Edit" (3:54) which is also edited for radio play. If you enjoy listening to artists such as Madonna or Amber then you'll certainly enjoy this cd from Kristine W.

On Rush, Finland's Ville Virtanen, better known as Darude, has kept his shiny techno sound intact, hoping to duplicate the success of the monstrous singles "Sandstorm" and "Feel That Beat" from 2001's Before the Storm. Rush may not reach that standard of dance floor nirvana, but the record is impeccably produced, with positive energy and shuddering thumps to spare. My personal fave is track 11 "Music" (orginal 12 inch mix). It's also exceedingly brainless, forgetting to mix up its sound and rhythms enough to produce the variety necessary for Darude's production mix to really take off. Actually, "mix" isn't even accurate, as it implies a record with some flow and purpose. None of these complaints matter when Darude is on, like when he gets a little dark on "Serendipity," then turns around and goes Ibiza for "Healing." A little more cohesion and a little less filler, however, could have turned this record into more than just a launching point for remixes that other DJs will use to far greater effect.

# Gay Games Could Bring at Least \$25 Million to Chicago

The Chicago Convention and Tourism Bureau has estimated that a Gay Games in Chicago would generate a minimum of \$25 million in direct economic benefit to the City and the region. In estimates provided to Chicago Games, Inc. the CTB numbers are based upon approximately 24,000 visitors to the Chicago region, 12,000 competitors and 12,000 friends, family and other tourists. The CTB Research is "conservative," and reflects a request from CGI for a number to help estimate the benefits if Chicago were selected to host the Gay Games.

"We view this number as a starting point," said Kevin Boyer, spokesperson for CGI. "Some Sydney experts have claimed an economic impact of close to \$80 million US." Economic impact numbers are estimates calculated by governments and tourism boards as they try to evaluate the benefits back to a community from travel and tourism. The Chicago CTB noted that while the numbers are conservative, actual economic impact could only be measured after the event had occurred.

## Advisory Council Vote

In related Chicago news, the City's Advisory Council on Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender Issues has joined more than 25 other community organization promising support for a 2006 Gay Games held in Chicago. The Council, meeting January 21, 2004, adopted a resolution without opposition that "recognizes the hard work, deep commitment, and level of expertise that Chicago Games Inc. brings to its planned bid to host Gay Games 2006." and resolves that the council "will provide and encourage all feasible and advisable support to Chicago Games Inc. in its hosting activities after a review of award terms if its bid is accepted by the Federation of Gay

Games." The sponsor of the motion further clarified that a November vote stating "the Council could not recommend a bid," should not be interpreted as opposition to CGI, but as a resolution offered at a moment in time when the Council felt it couldn't support the bid.

Members of CGI made a lengthy presentation to the Advisory Council at its January 21 meeting. During that meeting, they presented draft budget numbers, noting an overall budget of \$6.2 million with \$1.3 million from corporate sponsors. \$200K from tourism grants, \$2.7 million from athlete registration fees and \$2 million from ticket sales, visitor badges, fundraising, donors and license fees. "Our budget is still under development, but this Draft Budget #8 reflects a conservative approach that will ensure a financially stable event," said Boyer.

"We are grateful for the confidence shown by the Council in our work." said Mona Noriega, a member of the CGI Board of Directors. "If Chicago is selected to host the Gay Games in 2006, a partnership with the Advisory Council will help ensure even greater community involvement and responsiveness."

Chicago Games, Inc. is a nonprofit organization preparing a bid to host Gay Games VII in the summer of 2006. Bid documents are due February 1. 2004. with a decision by the Federation of Gay Games expected March 1, 2004. Chicago is competing against Los Angeles for the right to host the event.

# About the Gay Games

The Gay Games is a quadrennial athletic and cultural event which brings together people from around the world. Based on the principles of inclusion and participation, the Gay Games welcomes all people without regard to their sexual orientation, gender, race, religion, nationality, ethnic origin, political belief(s), athletic/artistic ability, age, physical challenge, or health status.



The Best Is Yet To Come • All Of Me • Fly Me To The Moon • Chicago • High Hopes • How About You? • I Get A Kick Out Of You • The Lady Is A Tramp • I've Got The World On A String New York, New York My Funny Valentine • My Kind Of Town • Something Stupid • Strangers In The Night • That Old Black Magic • That's Life Where Or When Witchcraft • The Way You Look Tonight • You Go To and Tony-winner Rita Moreno, and *The Ritz* just about has all the ingredients of a genuine laugh orgy—the jokes that flop do so largely because they've become somewhat dated.

That this film escaped the craze to remake every film that ever made a profit seems to confirm a trend toward more moderate sexual practices. That being said. *The Ritz* remains one of the funniest comedies about the freedom of precondom gay culture.

# La Cage aux Folles

La Cage aux Folles buoyed up the drag underworld for all to see in 1978: topics tagged as taboo suddenly became accessible to a wide audience. Still a cult favorite, this film did what *The Birdcage* failed to do: it forced the likes of Rush Limbaugh into a dress without compromising sympathy for those who put him into it.

Reversing the duplications slant of *The Gay Deceivers*, this story concerns a gay man (Ugo

Tognazzi) who agrees to play it straight to impress the conservative parents of his son's fiancé. Tognazzi then convinces his long-term lover (Michel Serrault) to hang up his drag act and play uncle long enough to get them all through dinner. Meanwhile, the son "de-gays" his father's apartment and asks his neglectful mother (Claire Maurier) to act as Tognazzi's wife.

Once the stage is set, nothing can stop the force of this farce; mishaps will occur, with exaggerated results. From Serrault's blatant jealousy of Maurier to the naked wrestler pattern on the dinner plates, the film moves briskly toward its inevitable and satisfying climax.

Although some viewers may object to the insinuation that gay relationships can be distilled into a heterosexual ideology, the well-drawn characters, finely-tuned plot and sharply-written dialog all contribute to the film's likeability. And unlike *Flesh*, which retains an air of modernism despite its age, *La Cage aux Folles* epitomizes the gay mentality of the past.

Is retro chic or geek this week? You might want to check the latest issue of *Wallpaper* to be sure. Failing that, try renting some of these classic gay films to help you decide who's in and what's out.

#### Flesh

Produced by Andy Warhol in 1968. Flesh was perhaps the first film of its kind to promote ambiguous homosexuality. The story follows a day in the life of a male hustler (Joe Dallesandro) as he hits the streets to earn the money to buy an abortion for his wife's girlfriend. At least, this might be his motivation; the movie remains deliciously unclear while coercing lust. longing and the occasional unexpected burst of laughter from its viewers.

Against a backdrop of cityscapes and seedy apartments, the compelling Dallesandro hangs out with johns, artists, other hustlers, transvestites, an ex-girlfriend and, of course, the quintessential gym buddy. He earnestly discusses being queer, being married and being a trick, all with the benefit of an eighth-grade education. Mostly, though, he gets naked.

With its jagged editing and documentary feel. *Flesh* maintains an erotic tone while pivoting between surprising poignancy and a warped sense of humor. And because the film's end loops back around to its beginning, it just manages to edge its way out of seeming randomness.

# The Gay Deceivers

Also released in 1968. *The Gay Deceivers* broke major ground by criticizing the army. the war and homophobia with its comedic premise about draft-dodgers who hide out in a gay neighborhood.

The plot. though, is sitcom thin. Two college guys (Larry Casey and Kevin Coughlin) flirt with the draft board to avoid being shipped to Vietnam; later, when they notice an army spy keeping tabs, the boys rent a one-bedroom in Fairy-land; when they resort to camp and vamp, hilarity ensues.

Yes, the characters come off as cartoonish. Casey's fre-

quently showcased—and superbly buff—bod is about as deep as the story goes, though Coughlin does endure a split-second or two of internal conflict. And the antics of the landlord (Michael Greer), though often funny, never stray far from the realm of stereotypical, limp-wristed queen.

And yes. what was considered the Gay Norm several decades ago could now slide easily into the Transgender category without much shoving. Protagonists Casey and Coughlin seem to embody those mystifying "straight acting" homos that were so trendy during the '90's, nearly nullifying the film's point. Still, the make-lovenot-war message does resonate, despite an unfunny brawl at the local gay bar.

While this film ultimately holds few surprises—a twelve year-old will probably anticipate the "twist" at the end—its sixties-era boldness cannot be completely ignored. However flimsy, effete and flawed. *The Gay Deceivers* remains a vital piece of gay Americana.

### The Ritz

Though filmed in England. Terrence McNally's *The Ritz* (1976). scored with US audiences and critics alike. Farcical to the core, the plot revolves around an average guy (Jack Weston) who decides to hide out in the Ritz to escape his maniacal brother-in-law (Jerry Stiller).

Unbeknownst to Weston. Stiller's "private dic" (Treat Williams) has also checked in. intent on a convoluted plan to blackmail Weston. And when Weston's wife (Kaye Ballard) shows up in drag, well. nobody's going home without a bit of nooky.

Set in a gay bathhouse equipped with movies, a steamroom, massage tables, swimming pools, a disco, a nightclub and free blood tests every Wednesday, the film flaunts its homosexuality with an abundance of promiscuous men wrapped in little more than handtowels. Add a pair of chaps, a Crisco oil party, a chubby chaser,

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


