State Sen. William J.
"Pete" Knight, a former
record-setting test pilot
who gained national attention authoring
California's ban on gay
marriage, died Friday
night after a battle with
leukemia. He was 74.

Sen. Knight, R-Palmdale, who has been absent from his seat since April 12, succumbed to acute myelogenous leukemia at the City of Hope National Medical Center in Duarte (Los Angeles County).

"This is a huge loss for California and America." said state Senate Minority Leader Jim Brulte. "Pete Knight was an original: a war hero, a test pilot and a man of conviction. He was always fighting against higher taxes and bigger government. He wanted more local control, and he fought for traditional values."

Knight first gained fame as an Air Force test pilot, setting a speed record on Oct. 3, 1967, when he piloted a rocket-powered X-15-2A that traveled 4,520 mph.

But it was his authorship of Proposition 22, the Defense of Marriage Act, which defined marriage as between a man and a woman, that vaulted him once again to prominence. The measure passed in 2000 with 61.4 percent support, though it continues to be challenged in the courts.

More recently, he spoke out against San Francisco's gay marriages, even as his own son, David Knight, joined the ceremonies and married his partner of 10 years.

"I love my son, but we continue to disagree on this issue." Knight said in March.

Born in Noblesville, Ind., Knight became a decorated Air Force pilot during the Vietnam

War and later went on to become a test pilot. pushing the limits of flight.

After his test-flying days, he served on the Palmdale City Council for eight years before being elected to the Assembly in 1992. Four years later, he joined the state Senate representing the 17th District, northeast of Los Angeles.

"The worst thing about this is he wanted to keep working, going, contributing," said Knight's wife, Gail. "He wanted to live. He wanted to try. God had a different plan."

A staunch conservative. Knight pushed for lower taxes, smaller government and safe-guarding military bases in California. He also was known for championing veteran benefits and pushing for housing for senior veterans.

"Along with being a national hero, he was local hero," said Former Assemblyman George Runner, the Republican nominee to replace Knight in the state Senate. "Pete succeeded in all the venues of his life, in the Air Force, the aerospace industry and as mayor of Palmdale and then in the Legislature. Pete just reflects so much of this community."

Gov. Arnold Schwarzenegger called Knight a "Renaissance man" and ordered flags lowered to half-staff. "The senator was a man who lived his life through his values, and was committed to the constituents whom he represented." Schwarzenegger said in a statement.

"He had the affection and respect of his colleagues, even when we disagreed on issues," said Senate President Pro Tem John Burton, D-San Francisco.

Knight is survived by his wife: three sons: three stepsons: one stepdaughter: and 15 grandchildren. Funeral arrangements are pending.



ragged at my 25-hour-per-week job? Why, gay softball, of course! I've already done a recruitment piece, and now it's time for an update:



Threesome

In *Threesome* (1994), mismatched college roommates Eddy. Stuart and Alex learn to come to grips with themselves and each other before being subjected to adult accountability. Thrown together by computer error—it thinks Alex is a male—the three quickly segregate themselves from the rest of campus in search of their own private utopia.

When Eddy (Josh Charles) admits his homosexual desire for athletic, salacious Stuart (Stephen Baldwin), the resulting platonic acceptance from Stuart that only fuels Eddy's homo-fire. Stuart, meanwhile, continues to pursue the snobbish Alex (Lara Flynn Boyle) with vigor, intent on redirecting her affections. And although she fancies the literary and refined Eddy, Alex nonetheless encourages affection from Stuart, perhaps to keep the lovers' triangle ablaze.

When the three decide to take Alex's convertible for a recreational spin in the country, their carnal longings shoot to the surface like the proverbial beach ball being let go underwater, implying that the wilderness has the power to loosen sexual yearnings usually held in check by more sophisticated locales. The coeds cavort in the nude among the jutting rocks and crystal pools, before long becoming an intertwined

bundle of fleshy limbs and open orifices a gaping troop of children on a field trip compels them to disengage and cover themselves.

The occupants of 3S do begin to show signs of psychological fragmentation as their private utopia begins to request a toll. Alex, specifically, caves under the pressure of the triangle, exposed nerves causing her to crack and begin screaming for the essential luxuries of the pampered elite. Stuart seizes his chance, aggressively bedding Alex while she's temporarily in this unhinged state: though their secret twosome continues throughout the semester. Alex still pines for the uninterested Eddy. Eddy. meanwhile, has convinced himself that the object of his affection is also gay because, though Stuart spews oral volumes about having sex with women, he never appears to get laid.

This classic three-way paradox intensifies until Alex gets both men to succumb separately. After informing Eddy she will "mold him into a heterosexual with her bare hands," she does her best to gain his coital compliance. Later he remembers the event with a sourness she cannot fathom, confiding in Stuart that he "felt like an impostor," the simple utterance of which amplifies the forthcoming pregnancy scare into a sophisticated sort of horror—none want a child yet all could biologically invent one. "Nobody's getting out easy," Alex informs Eddy, dripping with earnestness. "You understand that?"

The film culminates in the inevitable ménage—though some video versions are minus some explicit gay footage present in the theatrical release—that should satisfy anybody with a libido. With their communal fantasies at last realized, these three can then disengage and enter the adult world, actualizing the heightened awareness of those who have risen above mainstream perspectives.




