
I also want to thank the people who supported Club 5 after the events on Saturday and Sunday, and for their patronage of Friday's event with Pepper MaShay.



The Care and Maintence of Your Body Modifications

Hello everyone, it is great to be back with The EDGE Mag. We would like to thank The Edge for having us back. It has been over a year since our last publication and I'm not quite sure where we left off. So we are just goin to jump in and let you know some info on a subject we get a lot of questions about. Tattoos and Body piercings.

For those of you who have met Tom or myself (Marc) we used to work at the Oh Zone. We both have quite a few tattoos and body piercings. We have both had some horror stories and have worked with some of the best artists and Body Modification people in the area. And trust me. we both know the good, the bad and the ugly about the subject. Now with that said, let's start with Tattoos and the care and maintenance of your tattoo. Different tattoo parlors will tell you various methods of maintaining and care of your tattoo. While healing, one serious NO NO that I myself and others have mistakenly been instructed to do, is keeping your tattoo covered for days after getting it and putting loton on it every time you change your bandages. This is NOT the correct way to preserve your investment. Your new tattoo needs time to start a healing process and maintain the depth and color of your new tattoo.

STEP 1. Once you leave the parlor your tattoo should be covered. If your artist does not do this I would seriously consider finding a new artist. You need it covered it for several reasons. One being a fresh tattoo will bleed a little and some ink will seep back out from your skin. This is normal and you will want to keep it covered for TWO Hours only. After you leave your parlor. Then you can remove the bandage. some sticking can be occur. This is normal. Do not just yank it off, if sticking occurs, dampen the bandage and remove it. This is much easier and much

less painful. After you remove the bandage you will need to clean the wound to remove the lube that your artist should have applied to keep the bandage from sticking. You want to use a good antibacterial soap. They insist this be Dial antibacterial liquid soap. It does not sting and cleans very well. You might need to wash two or three times to clean it well with your finger tips in a lite circular motion. Do not use hot water trust me it hurts like a Beotch. Use room temp water, it works the best. Once it has been cleaned you are all set for a while. After you pat it dry don't rub or pick or scratch at it. Rubbing brings out the INK and it hurts so just lightly pat dry or air dry. Next, enjoy being sore for a while and nothing else. DO NOT PUT LOTION ON IT. You want your tattoo and skin to be able to breath and get a good head start on healing. To do this it needs air. If you work in an environment where it can get dirty, do not cover with a bandage, just wear a shirt that covers it loosely to keep dirt off of it. You want to do nothing with it for TWO days. as close to the hour as possible and it will be a little dry, but the Ink has been well set in at this point.

STEP 2. Once two days have passed you may apply lotion. The Only recommended lotion is Lubriderm Moisturizing Lotion and keep it handy you will want to apply it often every hour or so keep it soft and don't let it dry out at this point and it will feel much better also. Your colors will stand out very well. Then repeat this process until it is completely healed. This normally takes anywhere from 2-4 weeks. After 2-3 days, your tattoo will probably peel some. Again DO NOT pick or scratch at it.. After that just normal maintenance is required to keep it looking great for years to come. Most important, avoid prolonged sunlight or tanning beds they will make your tattoo dull and fade. If you must tan, cover your tattoo with SUNBLOCK. You want to keep your investment looking as good as you are. :)

This one is a little simpler. Body piercing just needs to heal. This can vary in the length of time depending on the type of piercing it is. I will get more into this in our next Episode, Body piercings just need to be kept clean, and cleaned often. Body piercings can bleed lightly, sometimes heavily (rare) for days, or even weeks. We recommend Claire's Ear Care Antiseptic. It is available at WalMart as well as various jewlery places, but WalMart has a very good price. It is located in the jewelry section. It is also painless, no stinging. You will also want to spin your piercing as often as possible to keep it from sticking. So it is just the two steps KEEP IT CLEAN AND SPIN IT OFTEN. In rare ocasions if your piercing gets infected or shows signs of swelling or redness around it, a sea salt soak can relieve the swelling and draw out infection. But for the most part Claire's antiseptic will keep infections from starting in the first place. About the only exception to this rule is for PA's (Prince Alberts), which is a piercing thru the penis. It is inside the urethra and goes thru the bottom of your penis just behind the the head. This piercing can tend to bleed more than others. In my case I was very lucky, it bled for a couple hours and was done. Daddy on the other hand bled lightly for a few days. This type of piercing you really don't need to do anything with. Do not use anything on it. The reason being that since it is thru the penis, it is actually self cleaning. Since Urine is sterile, it cleans itself every time you go to the bathroom. So, a good rule of thumb is drink lots of water and pee often. Your body will clean itself. Take it from me someone who has 7 piercings in my penis alone (so far). I do know how the best way to take care of them is. Ok, now that we know the basics you're off to a great start. Our other personal body modification Artist is Jim & Brent from Avant Garde in West Allis, Wi. (Milwaukee WI). Jim and Brent, some of you may have met at the Oh Zone during one of the two Body Piercing parties we had there when we worked there. They are are the best in the business, so if ever in Milwaukee check them out. Tell them we sent ya, they will take very good care of all your needs. **Avant Garde** is located at 7219 W. 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

Ray: Sincere – What you see is what you get.


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

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
