The first city I am going to cover is Milwaukee. Now everyone knows I am from Milwaukee so I am very familiar with what this city has to offer its visitors for nightlife. Milwaukee has a huge gay community and a wide selection of bars. Since I am not able to cover the 20+ gay bars we have, I am going to cover just a few of them.

When you come to Milwaukee and you want to go out, you have some ideas of where you want to go. The gay district is located in the third ward or the warehouse area. Most of the bars are located on 2nd and National. The one I'm going to feature this month is "Cage". This is the biggest bar and usually where most people go.

Cage is located at 801 S. 2nd St, right off National Ave. Taking I-94. Cage is Milwaukee's dance bar, possibly Wisconsin's biggest dance bar. Cage is two levels and soon to become three. The bottom level is open seven days a week, and the upper level is open five days a week. There is always something going on a Cage, so it's worth your time to definitely check it out!

The lower level is a laid back atmosphere. There are plenty of flat screen T.V.'s to keep you entertained. You can also play a game of darts or shoot a game of pool. The bar is definitely high class, with changing lights, and three panes of waterfalls. The lower level is home to "happy hour" which is where you will usually find Chris working. Cage has great drinks, and a good selection wines. The prices on the lower level are reasonable, mixers start at \$4.75 and go up to \$7, if beer is more your style, the prices would be \$4-

\$6. and for those martinis lovers prices range around \$9-\$10. But I do have to say if you are looking for a great Bloody Mary make sure you stop down and see Mike. The lower level also plays some awesome music.

Now let's venture to the upper or main level of the bar. This is the place to be if you want to party. The main level features four bars, and a huge dance floor. To get into the main level be pre-paired to pay the cover charge. If you have a cage card it will only cost you \$4, if you don't have a card it is going to cost \$6. While you are upstairs be sure to say high to the fabulous bartender "Topher", he's awesome! By the way, the drinks on the main level are the same price as the drinks on the lower level... The dance floor at Cage is HOT!. Cage was just remodeled last year right before pride. Now if you were up here during that time you would remember how Cage used to have two sides, now, it is just one huge open area AND they have added a suspended cage to the dance floor. It can usually hold about twelve people and can really be rockin' at times.

Cage also has an awesome sound and lighting system. No matter where you are on the dance floor there are always some sort of lights or lasers going around you. Their sound system rocks... the amount of bass and speakers around the bar will make you not want to sit still. Cage recently added a new DJ, and let me tell you, that boy can spin! You will never hear the same type of music all night long. He will spin anything from techno, to house, to R&B, to rap and yes, even all the way back to the old school dance songs, you just gotta love those... There is never a dull moment at Cage, and just about "anyone" should be able to have fun there. So if you are there to just chill in the lower level, shoot some pool, or if you want to get wild, dance in the cage, or on the boxes CAGE IS THE PLACE FOR YOU!

Now. Cage is not the only bar in the city. there are plenty of others to choose from. And it pretty much depends on what you're looking for. But I only had enough room to write about one this time. so don't worry. I'll be back next month featuring another bar and another city. 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



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
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






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Voice of Madison

And, God, did it remind me why!


You see, there's this girl I know whom I

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
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
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
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Miss A'Lotta Grease ... is the Word!
