





But I think we all need a refresh crash course of Sex ED! Below is a list of STD's and HIV and how many people are affected each year. Those are pretty big numbers huh? Chlamydia tops them all, and is known as the #1 STD in the United States. I saw some pictures of the STD's below, and it wasn't pretty.

The BIG Picture:

Chlamydia: - 4 million

Trichomoniasis: - ("trich"); 3 million Gonorrhea: ("clap"): 1,2 million Genital Warts: - (HPV): 750.000

Genital Herpes: - 500,000 Hepatitis B: - 300,000 Syphilis: - 120,000

HIV: - One million affected, and 45,000 new

AIDS cases reported each year.

What to look for:

As we round off the list, notice how many people are living with HIV. A lot huh? Did you know that 1 in 4 people don't even know they have the virus? This is
