



In the past several months, Madison has experienced an increase in hate crimes. It began in January when two UW teens were charged with 17 hate crimes for destroying a gay issues bulletin board at Ogg Hall (a dormitory on the UW-Madison campus).

This incident was followed by an attack on two teenagers on February 6, at East Towne Mall. The 17- and 18-year-old boys were leaving a mall store when two former classmates began making comments about the victims' sexual orientation. "Although this is still an active investigation and I can't comment, I can confirm that that this case is being pursued as a hate crime," stated Madison police detective Alix Olson. The most disturbing aspect of the East Towne Mall incident is that it happened inside the mall in front of numerous witnesses. "Surely the attackers must have known they were going to get caught," said OutReach board president Bill Turner. "That indicates a level of confidence on the part of the attacker that I think is very disturbing."

OutReach, Madison and South Central Wisconsin's lesbian. gay, bisexual and transgender community center and the Madison Police are strongly encouraging that individuals who believe they have been a victim of a hate crime report it immediately. "The Madison Police are very sensitive to the LGBT community, but if you feel uncomfortable contacting the police first, we recommend that you contact OutReach and we will help walk you through the process," stated OutReach Community Relations Coordinator Nikki Baumblatt.

On a bit lighter note, Perfect Harmony Men's Chorus (PHMC) will host its second Cabaret fundraiser on March 11 & 12 at the West Side Club. 
