in the '95-'96 lineup.





Recently-elected AW President Juliet Brodie
of Madison and AW Region III
representative Mike Fitzpatrick of Green Bay
were both selected by the program's producers

servative choice."



Fitzpatrick were interviewed by reporters and their
comments on the debate and Action Wisconsin
affiliations were printed in papers across the state.
