## QUEST EXPANDS OPERATION



Getting the printing presses up to the third floor *Quest* offices required a scissor lift among other equipment.

Approximately one year ago, *Quest* made a commitment to the Les-Bi-Gay community with the purchase of a printing press to print all future issues of *Quest*. Now *Quest* strengthens that commitment with the purchase of additional press equipment.

A few people made jokes as *Quest* became the first Wisconsin-based statewide gay publication in over ten years to be printed by gays, but, for the most part people's comments have been positive.

Most publications send camera ready

materials to a commercial printer and have the job done for them. *Quest* starting printing its own publication when we discovered how homophobic Wisconsin printers are. Ripon Community Printers told *Quest* the material we printed was objectionable and told us to either change or find another printer. What they objected to were 900 ads and pictures of male dancers taken in area bars. What this amounted to was censorship! We realized then freedom of the press for us meant owning our own press.

"I have to admit it was more effort than I thought it would be controlling quality, considering I had never run any printing equipment before," said Mark Mariucci, *Quest*'s owner and publisher. "A local printer, Insti Prints in Green Bay, made it possible by working with me to get me up and running, then help me troubleshoot." Printing *Quest* ourselves involves employing up to five gay people part time just to run the equipment. Small offset presses take more time to print than do the high speed web presses used to print newsprint. There are advantages though. We get to use higher quality white bond paper and keep our cost per issue in line at the same time. Our newest press will allow *Quest* to add more pages and color without making the print run any longer than it is. "My long range goal it to make *Quest* a premium quality publication including full color photography within the next twelve months," states Mariucci.

The addition of Bob Mazzacone to our sales staff in Milwaukee augers well for the future of Milwaukee businesses and *Quest* readers. There has been an opinion by some Milwaukee based businesses that *Quest* is only a Fox Valley publication. In fact *Quest* is distributed statewide and provides a much needed outlet for smaller communities as well as the metropolitan areas of Wisconsin.

*Quest*'s primary focus is providing a complete calendar of events but we are also searching for writers from all over the state to share their ideas and concerns with *Quest* readers. If you wish to become involved, we want to talk to you! Please call us at 1-800-578-3785.

God created each one of us in His image, He accepts us and loves us! MCC is Green Bay says.....Welcome! God is Love; He's not abandoned you!"

Hull continued, "Jesus reached out to the dispossessed, and we must follow. One of the most beautiful love stories in the Bible is the love of David and Johnathan."
