

PAST OUT

November 7, 1978 (19 years ago this week): Janet Flanner dies in New York City at the age of 86.

Who was Janet Flanner?

In the 1920s, a thriving lesbian artistic community in Paris allowed women such as Gertrude Stein, Alice B. Toklas, and Natalie Barney to live out their creative and personal lives with unusual freedom. But some of the women who participated in that scene aren't always recognized as lesbians the way Stein and Barney are - even though their love lives were just as woman-centered as the more famous expatriates. A good example is Janet Flanner, who was one of the most esteemed journalists of her time and a woman who took what she called a "lesbian approach" to life.

Born in Indianapolis in 1892, Janet Flanner wanted to be a writer from the age of five. After some setbacks, she launched her writing career in 1917, contributing an arts column to the Indianapolis Star for twenty-five dollars a week.

But like many lesbians-in-waiting, she found her hometown stifling, and she took one of the few roads out that were available to women at that time - she got married. In 1918, Flanner tied the knot with a friend from college who had settled in New York City. The marriage didn't last long, but it did change her life. Living in bohemian Greenwich Village with her new husband, Flanner immediately became part of the vibrant feminist community there and found herself attracted to the brilliant "New Women" around her. One of these women, a drama critic named Solita Solano, became Flanner's first great love.

Even the big city of New York, though, was not very tolerant of lesbians in the years following World War I. The two women felt confined by sexual mores and were eager to make a life together in another place. When Solano got an assignment in Greece in 1921, Flanner jumped at the chance to dump her husband and follow her new love abroad. The couple traveled around Europe, finally settling in Paris in 1922. Flanner and Solano became active members of the thriving expatriate lesbian community - frequenting Natalie Barney's famous literary salon and serving as the inspiration for the journalist couple "Nip" and "Tuck" in Djuna Barnes's 1928 satire, *Ladies Almanack*. In a 1973 interview with Mike Wallace on "Sixty Minutes," Flanner described Paris in the twenties as "lots of fun," but it was also a place where women like her could shed sexual and social restrictions and follow their desires and ambitions more freely.

Flanner lived with Solano for close to twenty

years in an open relationship, which at times seemed to involve some pretty complicated scheduling. Flanner's biographer quotes a letter written by one of Flanner's friends in 1932: "Janet is now in love with Noel Murphy, but she still keeps house with Solita Solano. Solano has a house in the country where she is in love with another girl and where Janet visits. Noel has another friend, some French woman, where she visits until Janet returns from Solita's" - lesbian soap opera, 1930s-style. Although she and Solano ultimately separated, Flanner retained a lifelong tie to her first love, proving that the tendency for lesbians to stay in touch with their exes isn't something new. And Flanner had a lot of exes. There was always "some woman who excited and charmed me," she wrote at the end of her life, "and when her influence waned, another took her place."

It's not just for her lesbian love affairs, though, but for her remarkable writing career that Flanner deserves attention. At a time when middle-class women's jobs were confined mostly to homemaking, nursing, or teaching, Flanner forged a successful and noteworthy career as a foreign correspondent. Her literary connections in Paris got her a number of plum writing assignments, and in 1925, the editor of the newly-founded *New Yorker* magazine approached her about doing a biweekly column on French culture and politics. Her "Letter from Paris," written under the androgynous pseudonym "Genet" (a twist on the French pronunciation of "Janet"), ran in the magazine for 50 years and earned Flanner worldwide fame. In the column, she tackled everything from tame subjects, like art exhibitions and the theater season, to explosively political ones, like the rise of French fascism. Her left-of-center work won many prestigious honors, including the Legion d'Honneur and the National Book Award. *Paris Was Yesterday*, a book-length collection of her columns, was an international best-seller. When Flanner died on November 7, 1978, her fans around the world mourned her passing.

Why isn't she better known as one of "our people"? Though open about her lesbianism with friends and colleagues, Flanner didn't discuss - and wasn't asked about - her personal life on the record. Not unlike many of today's semi-closeted dykes, Flanner seemed to think that everyone knew she was a lesbian without her having to announce it. As she wrote in a letter to a 1940s lover of hers, "Darlinghissima, how we burned and so publicly." More publicly than most 1940s lesbians, sure, but hardly "out" by our standards.





love AbFab, Randy can't stand it; but that happens to be my least favorite number, which he loves! (laughs) I do Liza [Minelli], which was very horrifying for me...

JL: Why is that?

PG: Going around to gay bars and being associated with drag queens, there's always a "Liza Minelli" out there. And nobody just does Liza—that's like an insult. I said, "Nobody gonna believe a short little lesbian trying to pull off Liza." I'll tell ya, people have said to me, "You're a dead ringer for Liza Minelli!"—which is such a lie!—that's been the biggest triumph for me in the show...

JL: Which one are you?

PG: That's what everybody wants to know! (laughs) I'm Catwoman. That's been a lot of fun...Probably my favorite number in the show is "Adam and Eve." [In the beginning] it was horrifying to both of us..."We were going to do what!!!!" I told Rand not to even look at me because it was his idea!!! Here we are standing out there [onstage], me with my three fig leaves, Randy with his one...it was pretty odd. "Hello, this is my butt!" (laughs) Sometimes, it's a little embarrassing.

JL: Gotcha. So, what's it like traveling with the CCRae Show? I'm not sure if everyone realizes you perform across the United States, not just locally. This is your job.

PG: It's a lot different than what I thought it was going to be. I thought it was going to be one big party. I was being paid to travel across the country and play in gay bars. (Whoops it up) But it is a lot of work. It's very grueling and very odd hours. We're doing shows anywhere

from four in the afternoon to 2 o'clock in the morning. There's two to eight hours of driving, get into the hotel, shower, change, get to the club four hours before the show, setup, do the makeup, do the show...by the time you're done, "Ugh!" We're wired but yet we're exhausted. JL: Most people think, "Yeah, well you get to see a lot of neat places and cities," but...

PG: Yeah. We don't see very much at all. Some of it being our choice, some of it not. We see a lot of the highway and a lot of the hotel. Most of the time we're in the city, in the hotel, and back on the road the next morning.

JL: Do you have a certain special someone in your life right now?

PG: Yes...we'll keep it private! Things are going well.

Before saying our goodbyes, Polly wanted to say this about Randy Bouche:

The one thing I want everybody to know is that I respect Randy Bouche as a performer, and someone who is so creative...Everything in all of his shows comes out of his head, and I just admire him. I wouldn't have jumped on the bandwagon and gone touring with someone who was an acquaintance unless I had a great deal of respect for him. What he's done with his show is amazing to me...he is a one-man wonder, as far as I'm concerned.

An Interview with Polly Griffin

Dateline: Early October. I'm sitting on the floor eating leftovers from whatever restaurant I patronized last evening, waiting for the party on the other end of the line to pick up. I'm waiting to chat with Polly Griffin, the female (genetically speaking)

half of the popular CCRae Show. About a month earlier I interviewed CCRae, aka Randy Bouche for northeast Wisconsin's favorite little rag. When we were done, he insisted that I also talked to his other half, and since I had enjoyed Randy so much, I figured I'd give the little Miss a try.

Polly finally picks up, and drawls a Hello my way that definitely sounds Virginian, yet still had some Yooper traits in it. As we both got comfortable, I started by asking Polly a little bit about her background before CCRae.

Jess Littleman: I've heard that you grew up in Wisconsin.

Polly Griffin: Yes I did—Milton, WI. Graduated Class of '89.

JL: Hell, I'm older than you! (Laughs) What were you like in high school?

PG: I was big into softball, and into theatre—I was as wild and crazy as I am now.

JL: Great! What made you decide to move up to Richmond, Virginia?

PG: Actually, I was working at the Classic Arts Dinner Theatre in Appleton...

JL: I've been there a couple of times.

PG: ...oh, I'm sorry! (laughs) A couple of friends that I had met there

were moving to Richmond together, and after a very tearful breakup with someone, I decided I wanted to leave the entire state of Wisconsin because she was there! Richmond was where a couple of friends were there, and well, it was centrally located to DC, New York...The mountains, the ocean...I wanted to get away from the cold weather!

JL: Sounds like Richmond is the place to do that. You mentioned working at Classic Arts. Have you always worked in the field of entertainment?

PG: Primarily after I discovered theatre t'hat became a big love of mine. Right out of High School I started working at the Fireside Dinner Theatre in Ft. Atkinson, I learned everything from backstage to onstage—anything you can imagine. Some friends told me about Classic Arts...[and in Richmond] I worked at a theme park [theatre] and other theatres...I have a lot of experience both technical and performance-wise. I have been very, very,

very, very fortunate—jobs have always landed in my lap.

JL: How did you get involved then with the CCRae Show?

PG: Back when I was in Appleton, and I met Randy. He was in a talent show at the Pivot Club, and I thought he was just the most hysterical persons I had ever seen. Kind of followed his career off and on. Then I moved to Richmond.

One or two years later, I saw that he was playing one of the clubs in Richmond, and of course I ran there! (laughs) I saw the show and talked to him. He came back a year later, talked to him again. He was talking about hiring a few people to go on the road with him. I said, "Oh, God, Take Me!!!". He said, "Well, I would, but you're too short."

JL: Really?

PG: I was, like, "What?" Randy said, "I want a male and a female dancer, and they have to be at least five-seven," ...when he is in drag he's

taller...I would look awfully silly being five-two standing next to him. In heels, he's five-ten! He said, "If I can't find anybody else to do it I'll call you—we'll work you in as a

comedy bit." He calls me a few months later and says it's just not gonna work out: "I'm bagging the whole idea—travel with me for a few months."

At the time I couldn't, but he called me about four months later and said, "I want to hire you!" That was a year ago in May. I came to Green Bay the end of February, and had a three week rehearsal; the rest is history.

JL: Tell us a little bit about the CCRae Show. You've performed around the state and around the country...you've been around, girl!

PG: Yep!

JL: What can we expect as an audience when we see the show?

PG: A whole lot of fun, I'm still amazed at the reaction that we have gotten in the Midwest and on the East Coast so far. [I've heard] from people, "When are you gonna be on Broadway?" to "When are you gonna have an HBO special?" We've gone into places that have big shows and drag shows all the time, and they say that this is the greatest show they've ever seen. After doing [a show] for a while you get bored doing it, and to get that kind of reaction from people night after night is probably the most rewarding thing that I can think of.

JL: Tell us a little about your characters.

PG: We do Pasty and Edina from *Absolutely Fabulous*. I

Next issue, I hope to publish inside poop on the Argonauts Charities, a fund started by the Green Bay Leathermen to benefit PWA. It started with CPI needing a couple hundred dollars to hold over PWA until other revenue sources kicked in. The Argonauts wrote the first check of \$300. Two years later, well over \$5,000 was raised. Now the whole NE Wis. community is involved. This is a cause you can give to without reservation.

I found myself seeking comparisons of the new Milwaukee Eagle to other leather bars and other Eagles. The best I could do was a private club in the basement of a centuries old building in Stuttgart, Germany.

The similarity was more than the thick walls and vintage. It was a seemingly endless catacomb, reeking with masculinity and inviting each ego to celebrate its own studliness.

And they did. WOOOFF!

You enter the complex via the game room with lounge seating, and with the fireplace pit still under construction. When complete and carpeted, it will be so inviting, you may not go to the main bar. But, you will where you will find the music upbeat and happy with the level encouraging conversation (what a concept!) and beverage consultants (aka tucking bartenders) with a ready smile and prompt service.

Next, the dance floor, which can double as a show lounge, has excellent lighting for a room without the usual high ceiling. Management is hoping the L/F community will also use this space for contests, run shows, as well as for parties.

At the far west end of the building and four steps down, is the Golden Shaft, a fair size room open on weekends, with a strict leather dress code.

Each section of the complex has its own personality and complements the overall image.

Miguel (overseer, decorator, manager, etc.) and Gus (owner) have pulled together an atmosphere that departs from the barn board, chicken wire and other rustic nuances that seem to tie most leather bars (Eagles included) to the same decorator's idea of masculinity.

I talked with folks from Green Bay, Minneapolis, Madison, Los Angeles, as well as many locals, and, with the exception of one person (of near my vintage) being carded, all were favorably impressed. Two men, visitors of leather bars on all continents except the two down under, had very positive reactions to the place.

Several overheard comments -- "I now have a reason to go out in leather in Milwaukee," "My trips to Chicago will be less frequent," "Some people now dress in leather," still another said, "I have never seen so many new leather men."

Not all is perfect, there is still work to be done. They didn't have VSQ Brandy, the bar lighting needs help, and, if that door opened to the outside, I wouldn't have broken a nail.


