#### HISTORY

### SATURDAY SOFTBALL BEER LEAGUE (SSBL)

The SSBL is starting its fourth year of playing softball. Four teams arranged "pick-up" games during the first year, 1977, and formal league competition began in 1978 with eight teams participating.


In 1978, the First Milwaukee Wreck Room Classic was held over Memorial Day weekend. Teams from New York, Toronto, and La Crosse joined the SSBL teams from Milwaukee, making this the first time more than two cities met on a competitive level. The Eagles Nest of New York were the first Milwaukee Wreck Room Classic champions. In 1978, Milwaukee also sent All-Star teams to Toronto for the Canada Cup Tournament and to New York for the second Gay World Series.

1979 was a big year for our league. The North American Gay Alliance (NAGA) awarded Milwaukee the Gay World Series III. Teams from Boston, Chicago, LaCrosse, Los Angeles, Minneapolis, New York, San Francisco, and Toronto joined Milwaukee's league champion, M & M, for the series held in Milwaukee over Labor Day weekend. Los Angeles' Rusty Nail nipped Minneapolis' Saloon in the final game. Because of the many preparations necessary for the World Series it was decided to forgo the Milwaukee Wreck Room Classic in 1979.

1980 looks like an exciting year for the SSBL. Ten teams from out of state will join the 9 Milwaukee teams over the Memorial Day weekend for the second annual Milwaukee Wreck Room Classic Softball Tournament. Eagles Nest of New York will join three other New York teams, Badlands, Boot Hill, and last year's World Series representative, Kelly's Village West. In addition, teams from Chicago, Connecticut, Houston, Minneapolis, Toronto Cabbagetown Group Softball League, and Toronto Riverdale Softball League will participate in the tournament.

In June, Milwaukee will send an All-Star team to Toronto for the Canada Cup. At the end of August, the SSBL Champion will join eleven other leagues in ten cities, and will represent Milwaukee iln the Gay World Series IV to be held in Los Angeles.

It should be a summer of fun and excitement for the SSBL and its fans.
